AP Capstone Diploma

- NATIONALLY recognized diploma in congruence with the high school diploma meeting the following requirements:
 - 6 full-year AP credits or combination of full-year courses and semester courses totaling 6 credits:
 - ✓ 4 credits from AP courses offered at AHS
 - ✓ 1 credit from AP Seminar
 - ✓ 1 credit from AP Research
 - Minimum score of 3.0 on each course examination
