Important information:

- **Fee:** A \$30.00 fee is charged to apply to this Educational Program Opportunity (EPO) for students that are NOT zoned for AJMS. If you ARE zoned for AJMS, you do not need to pay the fee.
- **Essay Topic:** The student is required to **handwrite** and upload a 150 -word minimum essay explaining why the student wants to participate in the Cambridge Program. The student must include information about their career and future educational plans. This essay is required to be uploaded and attached to the student's application. The student's application will NOT be considered complete until this essay has been received.

- **Teacher Recommendations:** During the application, you will be prompted to enter the email addresses of the two teachers that will complete the recommendations for your student. (usually the Reading and Math teacher)
- **Documents Required for Uploading:**  
After your application has been submitted, you will be able to upload the necessary documents listed below:
  - End of 5<sup>th</sup> grade year report card for the 2019-20 school year
  - First semester 6<sup>th</sup> grade year report card for the 2020-21 school year (January 2021 report card)
  - Handwritten Essay
- **Parent Notification:**  
After the application window closes on 2/26/21, all applicants will be scored through a rubric based system. We will be looking at the report card grades, essay, 6<sup>th</sup> grade Reading and Math formative assessments, and teacher recommendations. The scores are based on individual student performance. There is no lottery. We currently accept between 66-75 students per grade level.

During the week of **March 22-26**, parents will receive notification through the Family Dashboard if their student has been offered a seat.

You have until **April 9<sup>th</sup>** to accept or reject the seat.

If you do not choose, the system will automatically reject the seat.

If your student is waitlisted, the rubric score still applies, even when an out of district student applies at a later date. All waitlist students will be in rank order based on the rubric score from their application. We pull from this list in the summer. You will be notified by email/text if your student is offered a seat.
