- Approval of May 2023 minutes: Kit Kope made a motion to approve, MJ Newmann seconded, all members agreed.
- Treasurer's Report: Heather Goslin was not present at the meeting, but the last amount reported was \$3675.00. The new bookkeeper will verify the amount for the next meeting.

School Update

- Tim Powers reported that at the 6 day count, the enrollment was 1031 students. This year we have 10 new teachers, new principal, new guidance counselor, new athletic director, new bookkeeper, new AP of curriculum, and a new office clerk. Despite all of the changes, Cocoa Beach is fully staffed and ready to go.
- CBHS is in the middle of getting a new roof and should be completed by mid October. There's also a new marquee and a new intercom system being installed. The new A/C chiller needs to be fixed and we are using an older chiller for the time being.
- Parents addressed concerns for smoking in the bathrooms. These concerns
 will be addressed with more adult supervision and the Minga system which
 only allows 10 students at a time outside of class with a hall pass. CBHS
 will continue to follow the policies and procedures set forth by the School
 Board.

Old Business

• Christine suggested that we change the SAC meeting dates from the 3rd Monday to the 2nd Monday of the month. Emma Cummings made a motion to change from the 3rd Monday to the 2nd Monday, Kit Kope seconded, all members agreed. The time will remain 5:00 and the place will remain the media center.

- Fundraising: Kit Kope reported that from the A+ money awarded to CBHS last year, about \$5,000.00 should have been put in the SAC funds, so additional fundraising may not be necessary.
- SAC will sponsor a faculty breakfast in December with a holiday theme. MJ Newmann and Emma Cummings will create a sign-up genius for volunteers and items to bring in and they will set up and clean up.

New Business

• School Improvement Plan: These are the goals of the school, that if any monies being spent from SAC funds, must be tied directly to the SIP. The teachers have a direct input on the goals based on data and academic needs. One of the focuses is teacher input and morale.
