

Different Types of Dual Enrollment Opportunities at Astronaut High School

- 1. On-campus dual enrollment** – includes *Success Strategies for College and Life (SLS 1101)*. This is primarily a Senior level course and requires an unweighted 2.5 GPA as well as ACT, SAT or PERT scores on file (no minimum score requirements). The application process, including orientation, must be completed prior to the semester these classes begin.
- 2. Part-time dual enrollment** – classes are at the EFSC campus or taken online (off AHS campus): A cumulative unweighted 3.0 GPA is required and College Readiness Scores must be attained in Reading and English (Writing) on the ACT, SAT or PERT. The application process, including orientation, must be completed prior to the semester these classes begin.
 - 1 release period = 1 dual enrollment class
 - 2 release periods = 2 dual enrollment classes
 - 3 release periods = 3 dual enrollment classes
- 3. Early College Program** – classes are at the EFSC campus or taken online (off AHS campus): A cumulative unweighted 3.0 GPA is required and College Readiness Scores must be attained in Reading and English (Writing) on the ACT, SAT or PERT. College Readiness Scores must be earned in Math by the end of the Junior year.
 - Must attend a face-to-face Early College Orientation in 9th or 10th grade and continue on a path to earn an A.A. degree. Failing a required course for the A.A. or dropping below the GPA requirement is reason for dismissal from Early College.
 - Early College dual enrolled students are eligible for bus transportation to EFSC for 3rd and 4th periods.
 - Early College students stay on the AHS campus during 3rd and 4th periods on Friday's
- 4. Early Admission (Seniors only)** – Full-time classes at EFSC the **entire** senior year: A cumulative unweighted 3.0 GPA is required. The application packet for Early Admission must be completed by the deadline or the senior will not be considered for Early Admission. Packets are usually available for pick up by late February of the Junior year.
 - Only for Seniors, no classes at the high school or through Florida/Brevard Virtual School, 4-5 dual enrollment classes each term
 - Must have all required high school subject-area credits completed except 1 credit each in English, Math, Science and Social Studies
 - Meet the minimum 'college-ready' score in Reading, Writing, and Mathematics. Scores must be no more than 2 years prior to starting classes, **SAT/ACT scores must be on file at EFSC.**
- 5. Full-Time (Seniors only)** – Full-time classes at EFSC during **2nd semester only**: A cumulative unweighted 3.0 GPA is recommended, but a student can have below a 3.0 GPA; the application process, including orientation, must be completed prior to the semester these classes begin.
 - Only for 2nd semester seniors, no classes at the high school, 4-5 dual enrollment classes
 - Should have completed all required high school subject-area credits except elective credits
 - Must have minimum 'college-ready' scores in Reading and Writing. Scores must be no more than 2 years prior to starting classes, **SAT/ACT scores must be on file at EFSC.**
 - Students who do not have a 3.0 GPA are required to identify a CCC program as a postsecondary goal while in Dual Enrollment
