EAU GALLIE HIGH SCHOOL PARKING PERMIT AGREEMENT

There are a limited number of student parking spaces at Eau Gallie High School. If students wish to park on campus, they <u>MUST</u> have a school-issued parking permit. Parking permits can be purchased for a <u>non-refundable fee</u> of \$20.00. If a permit is lost or damaged, a replacement can be purchased for a reduced fee. ALL students must complete the online Pre-Registration form at http://tinyurl.com/EG-Parking. In addition, students must possess a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations apply to all students parking at Eau Gallie High School and will be strictly enforced. Parking tickets and/or permit revocation can and will occur for any student who does not abide by all school rules in regard to conduct and parking. This includes but is NOT limited to:

- 1. The current permit must be displayed on the rear view mirror.
- 2. Student parking permits are NOT transferable.
- 3. Students must drive the vehicle they registered or notify the front office of a change.
- 4. Students must park in their school-assigned parking lot.
- 5. There is a 5 mph speed limit in all Eau Gallie High School parking lots. Driving in excess of this speed limit, burn-outs, jumping curbs, etc... will be considered reckless driving and result in permit revocation.
- 6. No student is permitted to visit their vehicle or leave campus at any time without prior administrative approval or checkout!
- 7. Eau Gallie High School is NOT responsible for vehicles and their contents. Report thefts or damage to administration.
- 8. Any display of alcohol, tobacco, or times deemed in poor taste by administration on a vehicle is prohibited.
- 9. Chronic discipline problems, including excessive tardies, on campus or at school activities will result in permit revocation.
- 10. Failure to follow proper traffic patterns in the parking lot (exiting the lot in the designated fashion, turning in the proper direction, etc...) or blocking the entry or exit to school grounds will result in permit revocation.
- 11. Students are advised that vehicles are subject to search in accordance with state law and school board policy.

1 st & 2 nd Ticket	Ticket left on vehicle, fine to be paid in front office.
3 rd Ticket	Ticket left on vehicle, parent contacted, fines due.
4 th Ticket	Ticket left on vehicle, fines due, 1 day out of school suspension.
5 th Ticket	Ticket left on vehicle, parent conference, fines due, 2 days out of school suspension.
6 th + Tickets	Ticket left on vehicle, fines due, student suspended (each infractions) pending parent conference
15 th + Tickets	Ticket left on vehicle, student parking permit revoked until fines are paid.

^{**} A \$10.00 fine will be imposed for each ticket. Fines are cumulative until paid, but ticket count does not reset **

Eau Gallie High School Administration reserves the right, above and beyond the rules listed, to revoke a parking permit for any reason or tow the vehicle of any student who habitually violates the parking policy.
