Car loop Dismissal Procedures **(SEE ATTACHED TRAFFIC FLOW PLAN)**

- Kindergarten students, first grade students, and their siblings will wait in the hall outside their classrooms for pick up. A school-issued car tag must be displayed in the rearview mirror in order to have your child released for dismissal. If you fail to display a car tag, you will be asked to park, report to the front office, and show proper identification for checkout.
- Students in grades 2nd – 6th need to wait on the sidewalk on the WEST side of the building (bus loop area). A school-issued car tag must be displayed in the rearview mirror. If you fail to display a car tag, you will be asked to park, report to the front office, and show proper identification for checkout.
- Extra car tags are available in the front office with proper ID. Car tags will only be issued to the custodial parent.
