**Option 1: 2023 Summer School Program at Astronaut High School**

Students: 6 hours/day (8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.) **ON-CAMPUS** only

Taught by Astronaut High School teachers via Edgenuity.

**Option 2: At home through FLVS/BVS**

If your student decides to enroll in a course through FLVS/BVS, the course request must be approved by the counselor **prior to June 7th**. These courses must be completed by August 1, 2023 for credit to count toward promotion.
