

ESOL Training Guidelines

ESOL in-service credit points and/or ESOL college credits count as in-field for recertification of any coverage. Any points earned in excess of six semester hours or 120 points within one validity period may be banked towards the renewal of a certificate in subsequent renewal periods.

ESOL Endorsement: 15 semester hours or 300 in-service credit points added to an existing teacher certification area. ESOL In-service or Coursework must include all of the following areas: Domain 1: Cross-Cultural Communications Domain 2: Applied Linguistics Domain 3: Methods of Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) Domain 4: ESOL Curriculum and Materials Development Domain 5: ESOL Testing and Evaluation, or ESOL Endorsement: infused ESOL training in a DOE approved teacher education program, or K – 12 ESOL Certification: Passing Score on ESOL Subject Area Exam and 120 ESOL inservice points or 6 semester hours of ESOL training within three years of passing test	3 semester hours or 60 in-service credit points in ESOL by September 15 of the following year	3 semester credit hours or 18 in-service credit points in ESOL by September 15 of the following year *includes electives, support positions, and therapists	3 semester hours or 60 in-service credit points in ESOL.
