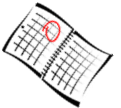


Shade for Sabal!

Coffee Chat with Administration

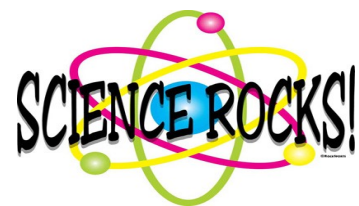
