Dress Code

Head-no hats, curlers, bandanas, hoodies, sunglasses (unless prescribed by a doctor) are to be worn in the school building or hallways.

Lower Garments- Pants should have no holes or rips. Undergarments should not be visible. Garments must be of length and fit suitable for the build of the child.

Upper Garments-No strapless garments. Straps must be at least 1 1/2 inches in width. Low cut necklines prohibited. Must cover the midriff.

Footwear-Students must wear shoes that are safe and appropriate for recess and physical education.
