CELEBRATIONS & COMMENDATIONS

Congratulations to **Christine Englund**, Family Advocate Extraordinaire! Three years ago, Christine set a goal to provide one book per school month for each of the 57 children she serves at **Saturn**. During that first year, using a combination of donations and her own personal funds, she distributed 57 books. Last year she distributed 342 books across 6 months, and this year, with the help of donations and pledges, she hopes to distribute 513 books across 9 months. Additionally, she will be providing parents with books during one of her family meetings. One of the donors to Christine's efforts was none other than **Mercer Mayer**, noted children's book author and illustrator. Mercer provided 60 assorted titles from his *Little Critter* series. Christine feels that these books provide an opportunity for students to make connections, "Little Critter is a friend that will always be there whenever one of our Head Start children opens their book."

Karen Rousseau presented her signature series, **Beyond Couponing**, to the women of Genesis House. Genesis House serves homeless women and their children, who are either working or in school, in a residential model of support. Karen creates a welcoming atmosphere and invites comments, questions and feedback. She understands the needs of families living on fixed incomes. FEDERAL REVIEW: FOCUS AREA 2 & CLASS

The review allows us to demonstrate our effectiveness in implementing a high-quality program to promote positive outcomes and school readiness for children and families.

- Both FA2 & CLASS observations will be completed this year
- We will receive a 60-day notification prior to the review
- Coaches will provide ongoing training and monitoring to support classroom teams
- Reviewers will visit classrooms, chat with teachers, and discuss classroom data such as GOLD & BDI
- Teachers will share how they align School Readiness Goals with the Head Start Early Learning Outcomes Framework (HSELOF), State Standards, GOLD and Creative Curriculum
- CLASS observations will occur in all/most classrooms
- CLASS observation data will only be shared at the *program level* (individual, classroom scores will not be shared).
