Try to pick out any sounds that could be considered musical, i.e., birds singing, wind whistling through the trees, etc.</p>	<p><b><u>LISTENING</u></b> Listen to "Moonlight Sonata" by Beethoven. Close your eyes and take deep breaths. <a href="#">Moonlight Sonata</a></p>	<p><b><u>CREATING</u></b> Using a simple song, create movement or body percussion for the words of the song. <a href="#">Row Row Your Boat</a></p>
<p><b><u>MOVING</u></b> Choreograph a dance for your favorite song. Teach it to a family member.</p>	<p><b><u>LISTENING</u></b> Listen to a song of your choice. Draw how it makes you feel.</p>	<p><b><u>SINGING</u></b> Sing a lullaby at nighttime.</p>	<p><b><u>CREATING</u></b> Create a rhythmic song using household objects. Think pots, pans, pencils, etc. (always ask permission from the owner of the objects)</p>	<p><b><u>SINGING</u></b> Sing the song "Do-Re-Mi" from the Sound of Music while doing the Solfege hand signs. <a href="#">Do-Re-Mi</a></p>
