

## Seventh Grade Math Readiness Packet Directions

Your child will bring home a packet of pages from their *Practice and Record Journals*. The content of this packet focuses on 7<sup>th</sup> grade standards that are highly beneficial for a student to be working toward mastery of prior to entering seventh grade mathematics courses. .

### Seventh Grade Courses

#### M/J 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Mathematics:

This is the standard course for 7<sup>th</sup> grade students and covers all 7<sup>th</sup> grade standards.

#### M/J 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Mathematics Advanced:

This is the advanced level course and covers some 7<sup>th</sup> grade standards and all the 8<sup>th</sup> grade Pre-Algebra standards to prepare the student for Algebra in 8<sup>th</sup> grade.

#### Algebra I Honors:

A 7<sup>th</sup> grade student placed in this course will skip both 7<sup>th</sup> grade math and Pre-Algebra to begin a high school class. Students will need to fill in gaps.

Tips on using this packet for parents:

- Have your child work through the problems in each chapter of the Record and Practice Journal packet that you received. S/he should focus on one chapter at a time.
- The solution packet that you received shows solution strategies for some of the problems. These are not the only strategies that your child can use to solve these problems. You need to decide when it is best to share the solution packet with your child.
- Check with your child and discuss his/her progress as appropriate.
