VERY IMPORTANT information about when you can participate in eLearning if you are attending school in-person on a regular basis:

Due to the COVID19 situation, we are requesting that our families keep their student home if they are sick. The only time a student should switch to eLearning is if they are out due to an illness, unless they are making the official transition to eLearning. We are getting a lot of phones calls of parents wanting their student to do eLearning for an individual day or while traveling. Students may go on eLearning if they are too sick to attend school, but well enough to do eLearning. Students that have been checked out or are not attending due to other commitments, such as a family trip/vacation or appointment, may not participate in eLearning but are able to make up the work when they return to school. Students may, however, log into their google classroom and work on any assignments that are posted there while out if they know how. Again, this is not required as they will be given make up days for the time they are out. Please note that first time eLearners may have difficulty logging in at home initially (many eLearners did the first few days of school). These concerns should be sent to Mr. McCutchan, our tech specialist, for troubleshooting so that class instruction is not interrupted.




A Friendly Heads Up on Prizes
