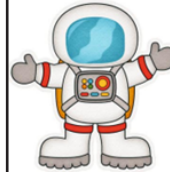

What: Campus tour, meet the teachers, visit kindergarten classrooms, PTO info, pizza "lunch" in the cafeteria, experience hands-on learning activities!


