## Westside Elementary School-Family Compact for Learning

This agreement explains how families and teachers will work together to make sure all students reach grade-level standards. ### School academic goal(s) and/or focus area(s)

Teachers and staff will collaborate and provide best instructional practices focusing on standards-aligned instruction to achieve and increase student proficiency and mastery in ELA, math, and science.

### Working together for success: In the classroom

Teachers and staff will provide a high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that supports students in meeting Florida's State Standards. Parents and families will be given an overview of "What their Child is Expected to Learn" for their child's specific grade. Through parent involvement events, parents and families will be given resources in each content area that align to Florida's state standards to be able to successfully work with their child at home.

### Working together for success: At home

Teachers and staff will maintain records of student academic progress and inform students, parents, and families through FOCUS, interims, report cards, and parent/teacher conferences. Parent and families will be encouraged to check student planners daily and review graded work sent home in their Thursday folders to promote academic achievement. They will review FOCUS regularly, as well as sign interims and report card envelopes. Parents and families will also ensure students maintain regular attendance and are on time to school.

### Working together for success: Student responsibility

Students will share the responsibility to improve their academic achievement and master the Florida State Standards. Students will come to school prepared for class, ready to try their best, and ready to complete class assignments. Students will also set goals for their learning and monitor their progress throughout the year.

### Communication: Staying informed

Teacher and families will use student planners, Thursday folders, parent-teacher conferences, FOCUS, Class DOJO, Class Tag, blackboard, and flyers, and weekly school newsletters to communicate to parents. There will be an Open House and Title 1 Annual Meeting held at the beginning of the school year.

### Building Partnerships

Staff will seek opportunities to involve parents to participate in school activities as much as possible (math night, science night, ELA night) and provide parents and families with resources and strategies to work at home with their child. Volunteer to serve on SAC and PTO.
