



Dear Future Mentor,

Thank you for taking an interest in mentoring a student at Freedom 7 Elementary School.

You have taken the first step in making a life-long positive impact in a child's life. Did you know that the student you are about to mentor is 78% more likely to volunteer regularly and 130% more likely to hold leadership positions in the future?

Dr. Mullins, the Superintendent of Brevard Public Schools, has challenged our school district to find mentors to serve the needs of our students, and you have stepped up to the challenge.

Click on the links embedded in the topics below and you will find information about the BPS Mentor Program and everything you need to know to get started:

- BPS Mentoring Program website that explains the BPS Mentor Process. Includes five training video modules (approximately 35 minutes in total) and a short quiz.
- Volunteer Application Website. Fingerprinting process.
- Mentor Participation Agreement.
- Sample Mentor Meeting Agenda.
- Mentor Role.
- Mentor Meeting Ideas.
- Mentee Goal Setting.
- Mentor Log.

When you complete the Volunteer Application, Mentor Participation Agreement, watch the video modules, take the module short quiz, go through the fingerprinting process and notify Chana Speir, at District Security: speir.chana@brevardschools.org of the date your fingerprints were taken. You will be notified when your background check is complete and you will be eligible to mentor a student whenever needed. When it is determined that a child needs a mentor, we will pair you with a student to mentor with that student's parental consent. Thank you for considering going through the process, so that we have eligible mentors ready to call on whenever the need arises for any of our Freedom 7 students.
